Due to damage caused by a fire at the Lipscomb Park Community Center on January 15th, use of the Lipscomb Park Community Center as a polling location has “temporarily changed” for the January 31, 2012 Presidential Preference Primary. Pursuant to Florida Statute 101.71, **The Front Street Civic Center, located at 2205 South Front Street, in Melbourne, will be used as a temporary polling location.**

The **Lipscomb Park Community Center** will continue to serve as a permanent polling location for future elections unless further notification is provided by the Supervisor of Elections Office.
