Artwork Guidelines:

- All entries must be accompanied by a completed Launch the Vote Student Art Contest entry form available at www.VoteBrevard.com.
- Entries must be submitted on **8 ½ X 11** white paper with a horizontal orientation.
- Students may use as many colors or forms of media (print, crayon, felt pen, pencil, etc.) for the design as they choose. However, any material that makes the design three-dimensional will **disqualify the entry**.
- Due to the nonpartisan nature of the Supervisor of Elections office, designs that reference party affiliations, candidates or elected officials **will be disqualified**.
- Student's name and school, in pencil, must be on reverse side of artwork.
