Meetings of the Canvassing Board are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of Brevard County Court Judge John C. Murphy, Brevard County Commissioner Trudie Infantini, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Pursuant to 286.0105, Florida Statutes, persons wishing to appeal decisions of this board may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
