Pursuant to 102.141 and 101.591, Florida Statutes, NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, November 8, 2013 for a recount (if applicable), Certification of the Official Results, Conduct of Election Report, and selection of the precinct(s) for the Post-Election Audit. The audit will begin following the precinct(s) selection.

Canvassing Board meetings are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the public. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of: Brevard County Court Judge John C. Murphy, Brevard County Commissioner Andy Anderson, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Pursuant to 286.0105, Florida Statutes, persons wishing to appeal decisions of this board may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
