The Canvassing Board will reconvene at 6:00 p.m. and a public meeting to begin the canvassing of Election Day returns will begin at 7:30 p.m.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, August 29, 2014 for the purpose of reviewing Provisional Ballots, certifying the 1st Unofficial Results.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 30 or Sunday, August 31, 2014 for the purpose of conducting a recount (if applicable) and submitting the 2nd Unofficial Results.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet on Tuesday, September 2, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of certifying the Election, completing the Conduct of Election Report, and selecting the Race and Precincts for the Post-Election Audit.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Canvassing Board will meet on Wednesday, September 3, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. to begin the Post-Election Audit.

Canvassing Board meetings are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of Board Chairman and Brevard County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, Brevard County Commissioner Andy Anderson, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose they need to ensure a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
