



Conduct Recount for Specific Brevard County Municipalities & Townships and Certify 2nd Unofficial Results for the November 4, 2014 General Election

Brevard County Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott announces that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 8:00 a.m., Monday, November 10, 2014 in her office located at 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Melbourne, Florida 32940.

The Board's meeting agenda will include the following:

- Conduct a machine recount for the Cities of Melbourne, Palm Bay and Barefoot Bay.
- Conduct a machine recount for the Town of Malabar
- Certify 2nd unofficial election results for the November 4, 2014 General Election
- Conduct a manual recount, if required

Notice is hereby given that the machine and manual recounts will be conducted in accordance with Florida Statutes 102.141(7) and 102.166 and Florida Administrative Rule 1S-2.031.

State law mandates an automatic machine recount if the margin between candidates or issues in the 1st unofficial results is 0.5% or less. An automatic manual recount is required if the machine recount results in a margin of 0.25% or less.

All Canvassing Board meetings are open to the public and will be held at the Supervisor's office located at 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Melbourne, Florida 32940.
