NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, October 26, 2015, to conduct a Public Test of the tabulating equipment used to tabulate Vote-by-Mail and Election Day Ballots, and begin the canvassing of Vote-by-Mail Ballots for the November 3, 2015 Municipal and Special District Election.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 5:30 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2015, for the canvassing of Vote-by-Mail Ballots. The Canvassing Board will reconvene at 7:00 p.m. to begin canvassing Election Day returns.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, November 6, 2015, to review Provisional Ballots and certify the 1st Unofficial Results. If a Recount is **not required**, the Brevard County Canvassing Board will certify Official Results, complete the Conduct of Elections and select the race & precincts for the Post-Election Audit.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, November 9, 2015 if a Recount **is required**. The Canvassing Board will conduct the Recount, complete 2nd Unofficial Election Results, certify Official Results, complete the Conduct of Elections and select the race & precincts for the Post-Election Audit.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 10, 2015, to conduct the Post-Election Audit if a Recount is **not required**. If a Recount **is required**, the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 12, 2015, to conduct the Post-Election Audit

All Canvassing Board meetings are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of Board Chairman and Brevard County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, Brevard County Commissioner Curt Smith, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose they need to ensure a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
