NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, October 14, 2016**, to conduct a Public Test of the election equipment used to tabulate Early Voting and Precinct Voting Ballots.

Note: This Logic & Accuracy (L & A) Test will be conducted at the Election Support Center (345 Wenner Way, Cocoa, FL 32926).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **2:00 p.m. on Friday, October 14, 2016**, to conduct a Public Test of the election equipment used to tabulate Mail Ballots. The opening and processing of Mail ballots will begin **October 25, 2016** and continue through **November 8, 2016**. This process is open to the public, press, political parties and candidates. A member of the Canvassing Board will be present during the opening of the Vote-By-Mail Ballots.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2016**, to review Mail Ballots. The Canvassing Board will reconvene at **7:00 p.m.** to begin canvassing Election Day returns and continue the canvassing of Mail Ballots for the November 8, 2016, General Election.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, November 11, 2016**, to review Provisional Ballots and certify the **1st Unofficial Election Results**.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet, if necessary, at **9:00 a.m. Monday-Wednesday, November 14-16, 2016**, if there is a recount.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet, if necessary, at **9:00 a.m. Thursday, November 17, 2016**, to certify the **2nd Unofficial Results**, if a recount is not conducted.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet on **Friday, November 18, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.** for the purpose of canvassing overseas mail ballots received within the 10 day count, certifying the **Official Election Results**, completing the Conduct of Election Report, and to select the Race and Precincts for the Post-Election Audit.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 22, 2016**, to conduct the Post-Election Audit, if a manual recount is not conducted.

All Canvassing Board meetings, **with the exception of the 9:00 a.m. October 14th L & A**, are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, County Commissioner Jim Barfield, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings.
