The Canvassing Board will reconvene at 7:00 p.m. to begin canvassing Election Day returns and continue canvassing Vote-by-Mail Ballots.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, March 18, 2016**, to review Provisional Ballots and certify the 1<sup>st</sup> Unofficial Election Results.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 21, 2016, and Tuesday, March 22, 2016, if** a Recount is required. The Canvassing Board will conduct the Recount and complete the 2<sup>nd</sup> Unofficial Election Results.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet on **Friday, March 25, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.** for the purpose of reviewing the Ten-Day Count Vote-by-Mail Ballots, Certifying the Official Election Results, completing the Conduct of Election Report, and the selection of the Race and Precincts for the Post-Election Audit.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 28, 2016**, to conduct the Post-Election Audit.

All Canvassing Board meetings, **with the exception of the February 24<sup>th</sup> L & A**, are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, County Commissioner Jim Barfield, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings.
