NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, October 30, 2017**, to conduct a Public Test of the election equipment used to tabulate Mail Ballots and Precinct Voting Ballots, and begin the canvassing of Mail Ballots for the November 7, 2017 Municipal and Special District Election. This process is open to the public, press, political parties and candidates. A member of the Canvassing Board will be present during the opening of the Mail Ballots.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **5:30 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 7, 2017**, to review Mail Ballots. The Canvassing Board will reconvene at **7:00 p.m.** to begin canvassing Election Day returns and continue the canvassing of Mail Ballots.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **5:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 9, 2017**, to review Provisional Ballots and certify the **1st Unofficial Election Results**. If a Recount is **not required**, the Brevard County Canvassing Board will continue and certify the Official Results, complete the Conduct of Elections and select the race & precincts for the Post-Election Audit. The Post-Election Audit will be held on **Tuesday, November 14, 2017 at 9:00 a.m.**

If a recount **is required**, notice is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. Tuesday, November 14, 2017**, to conduct the Recount and certify the **2nd Unofficial Results**. The Canvassing Board will certify Official Results, complete the Conduct of Elections and select the race & precincts for the Post-Election Audit. The Post-Election Audit will be held on **Thursday, November 16, 2017 at 9:00 a.m.**

All Canvassing Board meetings are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. All meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, County Commissioner Curt Smith, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings.
