All Canvassing Board meetings will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of Board Chairman and Brevard County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, Brevard County Commissioner Rita Pritchett, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose they need to ensure a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
