Note: This Logic & Accuracy (L & A) Test will be at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office (2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Viera, FL 32940).

The opening and processing of Mail Ballots will begin at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, August 13, 2018** and continue until **7:00 p.m. on Election Day**. This process is open to the public, press, political parties and candidates.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. (if necessary) and 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, August 28, 2018**, to review Mail Ballots and begin canvassing Election Day returns and continue canvassing Mail Ballots.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, August 31, 2018**, to review Provisional Ballots and certify the 1st Unofficial Election Results.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 1, 2018 and Sunday, September 2, 2018, if a Recount is required**. The Canvassing Board will conduct the Recount and complete the 2nd Unofficial Election Results at **9:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 2, 2018**.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet on **Tuesday, September 4, 2018, at 9:00 a.m.** to Certify the Official Election Results, complete the Conduct of Election Report, and select the race and precincts for the Post-Election Audit.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet at **9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 5, 2018**, to conduct the Post-Election Audit.

All Canvassing Board meetings, **with the exception of the 9:00 a.m. Friday, August 10th L & A**, are held at the Supervisor of Elections Viera Office, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Building C, Viera, Florida. Meetings are open to the press, public, political parties, and candidates. The Brevard County Canvassing Board is comprised of County Court Judge Kenneth Friedland, County Commissioner Rita Pritchett, and Supervisor of Elections Lori Scott.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at these meetings/hearings they will need a record of the proceedings.
