New 'I Voted' stickers for kids

Starting with the early in-person voting for the Aug. 28 primary, children who come to polling places with their parents will be getting special stickers that say "I Voted with Mommy" or "I Voted with Daddy."

So, now, the kids won't have to share the regular "I Voted" stickers with their parents.
